



The Bluffton Parks Department has partnered with Wells County Rock in a community initiative created to spread joy and encourage creativity. Be creative as you paint on rocks and hide them for others to find.

What Do I Need To Get Involved?

Rocks (Can be purchased in bags at many garden centers)

Acrylic paint or paint pens. Some people choose to spray paint the rocks before painting.

Sealer (Krylon Acrylic Spray Sealer works great as does Rustoleum Clear Matte Spray Sealer.

Many have also used a brush on called "Triple Thick" for a high gloss finish

Let's Talk Rocks

Be creative. Paint anything on your rock or be inspired by the shape!

If you want your rock to be found and shared on the Facebook page, here are a few ideas for the back of your rock.

1. Draw the Facebook "f" and write WC Rocks!
2. Write WC Rocks! on Facebook
3. Post a picture on Wells County Rocks! on Facebook

What If I Find A Rock?

Snap a photo of you with your treasure and post the picture on the Wells County Rocks! Facebook page. Keep your rock or re-hide it

How Can I Get My Community Involved?

Invite everyone you know to the Wells County Rocks! Facebook page. The more painters and planters, the more joy that is spread.

Now What?

Go out and plant your rocks! Hide them in the Bluffton City Parks where you expect someone will find it and smile. Be sure to keep rocks outside and out of the way of grass that will get mowed. If you are hiding a rock at any other location make sure you get permission first. You can then post a photo of the hidden rock with clues to the location if you want.
