## Bluffton Police Department Hiring Police Officer!

The Bluffton Police Department is accepting applications for the position of police officer. Applicant must be 21 years of age by close of application date, but less than 36; have a high school diploma and two-year college degree or equivalent (60 hours), or two years of work experience in a police-related field or be a graduate of the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy Tier I basic class or equivalent. Must provide college transcripts. Applicant must possess and maintain a valid Indiana driver's license and responsible work experience. Applicant must pass a background investigation, written test, physical agility test, oral interview, voice stress examination, required statewide baseline physical and psychological examination and drug test.
