

Roush Golf Cart Parking



The Bluffton Parks Department is designating the side yard of Roush Park to be used as golf cart parking. This is the only area besides the designated car parking spots where golf carts are allowed to park.

GOLF CART REMINDERS FOR CITY RESIDENTS: The City of Bluffton has been fortunate to have had a very safe track record in regards to the operation of Golf Carts by residents within the city limits. We have a strong desire to keep a good thing going, and we need your help! Please review the following reminders as detailed in City Code 10.14:

- Registration (\$30) is required at the police station.
- Golf Carts must be designed to be golf carts, not an ATV, UTV, Gator, etc.
- Golf Cart must have a VIN # and owner must provide proof of insurance upon registration.
- Golf Carts must display the high visibility flag provided upon registration.
- Golf Cart operators must be at least 16.5 years old and have a photo ID with them.
- A maximum of six (6) occupants per Golf Cart allowed; no riders under two (2) years old allowed. All occupants must remain seated.
- Golf Cart operators must obey all traffic laws.
- Golf Carts are only permitted to be driven from 30 minutes prior to sunrise until 30 minutes after sunset unless equipped with headlights, taillights, brake lights and turn signals.
- Golf Carts are only permitted on city streets where the speed limit is 30 mph or slower. Golf Carts may only directly cross a state highway while on a city street. **Golf Carts are prohibited from all sidewalks, trails, pedestrian bridge and greenway path.**
