



# Bluffton Parks Department Splash Pads

**2 Locations:** 304 E Washington Street at Pickett's Run Park

925 W Silver Street at Roush Park

**Hours:** 10am-9pm

**Dates:** Opens by Memorial weekend and closes the day after Labor Day.

## **Rules:**

The City of Bluffton assumes no liability for loss, damage, or any type of injury or accident to persons or property  
To activate the spray, touch the black button on the post.

A Splash pad is a parent-supervised facility. Children should be accompanied by a responsible party

Please take children on frequent restroom breaks (every 30-60 minutes is recommended)

Children with diapers are required to use swim diapers

Persons with open sores, blisters, cuts, or diarrhea are not to use the facility

At the first sign of thunder or lightning, vacate the splash pad and seek a fully enclosed shelter for at least 30 minutes after the last sign of thunder or lightning.

## **NO TO THE FOLLOWING:**

Food, candy, gum, beverages, or glass containers

Inflatable pool toys, athletic and/or recreation equipment, including cleats

Horseplay, pushing, running, or roughhousing

Sitting on spray nozzles or drains

Soaps, detergents, and shampoos

Inappropriate behavior, language, music, or apparel

Alcohol, tobacco, weapons, or illegal drugs

Chairs, umbrellas, tables, or canopies on the splash pad

Skateboards, skates, Razors®, rollerblades, scooters, bicycles, or similar equipment

Animals allowed on pad

Smoking within 50 feet of the splash pad
