

# Tree Planting Program

The City of Bluffton will assist residents in planting trees along city streets during the early spring of 2023. Trees will cost \$37.00 each. Trees will arrive in a 5-gallon container. They must be ordered and paid for by March 17, 2023.

*Trees offered are:*

Red Sunset Maple  
Eastern Redbud - Pink Blooming  
Kousa Dogwood-White Flowering  
Heritage River Birch - Multi Stem  
Tulip Tree

(Quantities are limited again this year)

The city will assist homeowners in planting the trees, provided the location can be reached from the street by the city's equipment. If you wish, the trees will be delivered to your home for you to plant. Trees are expected to arrive late March or early April.

The city will be purchasing the trees from Steve's Outdoor Concepts in Bluffton. *The City cannot guarantee the tree's growth, since much of the success of a planting depends upon the care of the tree after it is in the ground.*

Trees may not be planted in alleyways, under utility lines or where the growth of the tree may endanger either overhead or underground utilities.
