- Reside in Harrison or Lancaster Township or any township adjoining.
- Have no record of felony convictions
- Have no misdemeanor conviction of domestic violence
- If prior military, be honorably discharged
- Hold current certifications in Firefighter I & II, NIMS 100, 200, 700 & 800, Hazmat Operations, EMR or EMT (Minimum of Emergency Medical Responder certification is desired). **Or be willing to get these certifications.**
- Be of good moral character and possess a high degree of honesty and integrity
- Possess an acceptable level of verbal and written skills to successfully execute the essential duties and functions of the job
- Possess an acceptable level of dexterity to successfully execute the essential duties and functions of the job
- Possess the ability to interact appropriately with the public, employees, team members, elected officials and others
