Hint, the animal will be in a different location than its tracks, and there can be up to at least 2 pictures hidden in some parks. Hopefully you have a good memory to remember where you found the animal and where the tracks were located! Once you have located and matched all the animals to their tracks, you can turn in your Animal tracks form by May 31st to the Bluffton Parks Department office, located on the 2nd floor of the City Hall Building (128 E. Market), to be entered into a drawing for a prize.
